Free tax assistance available

HILLSDALE — The Community Action Agency will once again be offering free income tax preparation during tax season.

Last year more than 1-1,000 residents in Hillsdale, Lenawee and Jackson counties took advantage of the program. Residents with a 2-013 household income of \$5-2,000 or less are eligible for the free preparation.

IRS certified volunteers assist individuals and families with their tax preparation. Seniors are encouraged to utilize the service, even if they think they do not have to file federal tax returns, because they may be missing out on state credits.

Volunteers will prepare federal, state and city tax forms, along with tax credits including: earned income tax credit, home heating credit, child tax credit and homestead property tax credit. All forms are prepared and filed at no cost.

Appointments are scheduled by calling the Community Action Agency from 8 a. m. to 5 p. m.

Monday through Friday.

Hillsdale County residents can call (5-17) 437-3-346 and Lenawee County can call (5-17) 263-7-861.

Appointments are available days, evenings and weekends at a variety of sites around the three counties.

CAA's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program is available year round to assist clients whenever they need assistance.
