New program offers assistance for veterans

HILLSDALE—Community Action Agency (CAA) in Jackson, Lenawee and Hillsdale counties, along with its subcontractor Housing Help of Lenawee, has a new service for veterans and their families.

The Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) is a new program designed to promote housing stability among very low-income veteran families who reside in or are transitioning to permanent housing.

The program works to help homeless or near homeless veterans, both individuals and families, gain access to housing and services.

'Our first goal is housing stabilization for veterans and their families to secure safe and affordable housing,' said Tami Farnaum, program operations manager at Community Action Agency.

The CAA under the SSVF program will provide case management services, including linking veterans and their families to community resources that can address other needs affecting their housing crisis.
