## Home heating credit deadline approaching

HILLSDALE — The deadline to file for the 2013 home housing credit is approaching.

Applications for the 2013 state home heating credit must be filed by Sept. 30. Failure to file for the credit by Sept. 30 results in the loss of the money.

Eligibility for the home heating credit is based on several factors, including family size and income. Those whose heating is included in their rent may also be eligible to receive home heating credit. If the taxpayer is disabled, extra exemptions may be permitted toward the home heating credit.

Those who only receive social security or SSI and are not required to file a Federal or State tax return may be eligible for a home heating credit.

Those who have filed their 2013 Michigan taxes probably already filed for the credit.

Those who have not filed and have a household income less than \$52,000 may call the Community Action Agency to schedule an appointment to file for the credit.

CAA provides free tax-preparation services through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program for any household with an income is less than \$52,000.
