Great Start, Parent Network kick off 2016 Diaper Drive

Lenawee Great Start Collaborative and the Parent Network are sponsoring the fourth annual diaper drive to help families in need.

According to drive organizers, there are more than 500 babies in Lenawee County living in families below the poverty level and in need of six to 10 diaper changes a day. Most childcare centers do not accept cloth diapers and many laundromats have restrictions on against washing cloth diapers in their facilities.

The goal is to collect 10,000 diapers by May 31. Lenawee Great Start has set up 24 diaper drop off locations. Collection bins can be found at the following locations: Tecumseh City Hall, Police Department entrance; Lenawee United Way; The Centre; all First Federal Bank in Lenawee County; Great Start office at the Lenawee Intermediate School District's Porter Center; all TLC Community Credit Union locations in Lenawee County; all Old National Bank Location in Lenawee County; Planet Fitness and the Joe Ann Steele Insurance Agency.

Lenawee Great Start is also collecting cash to purchase diapers. Donations may be mailed to Lenawee Great Start at 2946 Sutton Road, Adrian, MI 49221.
