## Health center gets donations

Jackson's Center for Family Health has received about \$15,000 from CP Federal Credit Union and Community Action Agency for its new downtown health center.

The credit union gave a \$10,000 donation toward the construction cost of the 54,000-square-foot health facility, scheduled to open next summer. With a federal Medicaid match and a challenge match from the Weatherwax Foundation, the gift amounts to \$81,600.

The Community Action Agency gave a donation of \$4,890. With a federal matching grant, the gift becomes \$19,951.

Jane Robinson, the center's development coordinator, said the Alro Steel Foundation also made a donation but did not want the amount publicized.

The Center for Family Health has reached 75 percent of its \$10.7 million construction goal.
