Community Foundation announces awards

The following organizations are recipients of the most recent adult grant cycle of the Hillsdale County Community Foundation.

A total of \$54,970 was awarded to area non-profit organizations for projects or programs to benefit Hillsdale County residents.

- Reading Community Fire Department, \$7,175, to train fire department personnel as medical first responders and to assist with the cost of purchasing the necessary supplies to upgrade the department to the MFR level.
- Special Olympics Michigan Area 29, \$1,700, to purchase uniforms, shin guards and socks for area athletes participating in the Special Olympics soccer program.
- Community Foreclosure Coalition,\$30,000, to provide services to Hillsdale County residents through the Foreclosure Prevention Counseling program.
- Hillsdale County Agricultural Society, \$10,000, to assist with start-up costs for a donut-making operation at the Hillsdale County Fairgrounds, which will serve as an ongoing fundraiser for the Fairgrounds.
- Hillsdale College, \$3,000, for performance fees for violinist Jasper Wood and pianist David Riley to perform at the Sage Center for the Arts during the 2010-2011 academic year. The performance will be open to the public and free of charge.
- Hillsdale County Senior Services Center Community Action Agency, \$3,095, for the purchase of a NuStep T4 Recumbent Cross Trainer, to be used in the Perennial Park Fitness Center.
