# Partnership Park gets its own Web site

Partnership Park now has a central location for information.

The downtown neighborhood association's Web site, [www.partnershippark.org](http://www.partnershippark.org), went online Wednesday. It has news, information about programs and services, a cal-

endar of events, list of partners and brief history of the association.

The Rev. Jay Cummings, secretary of the Partnership Park board, said the site will help the association share information with residents, community partners and other neighborhood associations.

"I think it will be a way for

us to get the word out a little further and a little bit faster," Cummings said.

Jon Hart, community organizer with the Community Action Agency, said the association has so many partners — 13 organizations and businesses are listed on the site — people sometimes have a hard time finding information about it, so the site is the

one place they can go to get what they need.

"It's basically like a virtual community," Hart said. "I think it will be a great asset." Hart has been gathering information for the site for months and plans to post more events, photographs and documents.

The site was built by Jackson-based AMS Develop-

ers. AMS Vice President Sue Kurczewski said the biggest challenge was to combine a lot of different pieces of information and yet make the site easy to navigate.

Hart said Kurczewski did a great job designing the site, and now that it's up, the association will focus on publicizing it and making sure it's updated regularly.
