New Center for Family Health headquarters in downtown Jackson 'worth the wait'

Hundreds of local residents, staff members and community leaders celebrated the grand opening of the **Center for Family Health's new \$11 million headquarters** in downtown Jackson this afternoon.

"This project has been a joy from start to finish," said the center's executive director, Molly Kaser. "It was worth the wait."

Construction began one year ago. The new building is consolidating several of the center's offices into one facility.

U.S. Sen. Debbie Stabenow said the building was the culmination of a tremendous amount of hard work and will be a benefit to families and local residents who can make just one stop for quality medical care.

Earlier in the day, the board room in the complex was dedicated to Marsha Kreucher, CEO of the Jackson area's Community Action Agency, for her "pivotal role" in getting the organization started, Kaser said.

Throughout the afternoon, people streamed into the three-story structure and toured the luxurious new facility.

By the end of the month, Kaser said about 180 people will be working at the downtown campus.
